Cirka is committed to protecting human rights.

At Cirka, we are committed to protecting human rights, upholding ethical labour standards, and ensuring our operations and supply chains are free from modern slavery, forced labour, and child exploitation.

We recognise the inherent risks of modern slavery within the cleaning services industry, particularly where subcontracting and vulnerable worker cohorts are involved. As we grow and prepare to meet our formal obligations under the Modern Slavery Act 2018 (Cth), Cirka affirms its role as a responsible business that goes beyond compliance to lead with integrity, transparency, and accountability.

We do this not because we have to, but because we believe it is the right thing to do. Acting ethically is core to who we are as a business and reflects the values we expect from our people, our partners, and our industry.

In line with our values and Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) priorities, Cirka is committed to the following principles:

- Zero Tolerance: We uphold a zero-tolerance stance toward all forms of modern slavery, including forced labour, deceptive recruitment, debt bondage, and child labour.
- Ethical Supply Chains: We expect all suppliers
 and subcontractors to operate in accordance with
 our Supplier Code of Conduct, which prohibits
 modern slavery and child labour and sets clear ethical
 expectations throughout the value chain.
- Responsible Procurement: We consider the risk
 of modern slavery in all purchasing decisions and
 apply due diligence when selecting and working with
 suppliers. We choose to work with partners who treat
 workers fairly, meet legal obligations, and demonstrate
 ethical labour practices.
- Transparency and Accountability: We are committed to openly communicating how we manage modern slavery risks across our operations and supply chains. We aim to build trust with all stakeholders clients, employees, and suppliers—by being clear, consistent, and accountable in our actions.
- Capability and Awareness: We are committed to building internal awareness and capability through ongoing education, training, and engagement with trusted partners, including our membership in the On Us Business Coalition for Safeguarding Children.
- Child Safeguarding: We recognise the responsibility
 of businesses in protecting children from harm. Our
 practices incorporate child safeguarding measures and
 reflect our belief that child safety is not just a social
 responsibility, but a business imperative.
- Continuous Improvement: We will continuously review and refine our frameworks, policies, and practices to remain aligned with evolving legislation, stakeholder expectations, and leading industry standards.

Governance & Accountability

Cirka's ESG Committee provides governance oversight and ensures that our commitments to ethical labour practices are embedded into core business decisions. We expect our suppliers to uphold the same standards and reserve the right to disengage from any party found in breach of our expectations following appropriate review.
